#### **Board of Selectmen**

### Acceptance of the Minutes

#### Town Administrator's Report

The next order of business on the Town's financial calendar will be the tax classification at the end of November/beginning of December.

#### Correspondence

Correspondence was received from Frank Martell of Raynham, of his interest in serving on both the Appeals Board and Conservation Commission. Mr. Pacheco suggested forwarding the letter to both boards for their process. Mrs. Roberts made a motion to send the letter to both Boards, Mrs. Smith seconded and Mr. Pacheco made it unanimous.

Correspondence was received from Chief Januse commending several Officers from the Police Department who had gone above and beyond the call of duty when the Fire Department was shorthanded and a call came in for a house fire on Suzanne Drive.
