New Business

Town Administrator's Report

Mr. Buckner reviewed the Town Administrator's Report. The tentative date for the tax classification hearing is December 6th. The Assessors, Treasurer/Collector, Accounting and other departments are working to get everything ready for that hearing and to present to the Department of Revenue to get the tax rate approved.
