McKinnon Meeting Room, 558 South Main Street, Raynham, MA are relative to filing and joint hearings and/or meetings under M.G.L Ch 131, Section 40, as amended, and the Town of Raynham Wetland Protection Bylaw.

• Request for Determination of Applicability – 110 South Street East

• Continued Notice of Intent – 280 Church Street

Motion: Moved by Mr. Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Campbell to approve the Notice of Intent for 280 Church Street. Discussion: None. Vote: 3-0-0

• Continued Request for Determination of Applicability - 260 Church Street

Motion: Moved by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Reynolds to issue a Negative 3 Determination of Applicability for 260 Church Street with the install of the erosion control and certified by the surveyor including inspection by the Conservation Commission prior to work commencing. Discussion: None. Vote: 3-0-0

• Continued Request for Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation - 260 Church Street Motion: Moved by Mr. Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Campbell to approve the Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation for 260 Church Street, DEP 260-1043 based on the area presented to the Commission. Discussion: None. Vote: 3-0-0

• Certificate of Compliance – 140 Gardiner Street

Mr. McRae informed that a septic system was installed at 140 Gardiner Street and wetlands were disturbed. **Motion:** Moved by Mr. Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Campbell to issue the Certificate of Compliance for 140 Gardiner Street. Discussion: None. Vote: 3-0-0

• Discussion of Modification – Raynham Riverwalk LLC, DEP 269-0695

The project was issued an Order of Conditions in 2019 and the Order was amended in 2021 to increase to 138 units under 40B. The Zoning Board of Appeals approved the project in 2022 for the 138 units under 40B Comprehensive Permit.

Present was David Eastridge, Thorndike Development Company and Mark Flattery. Mr. Eastridge informed that Thorndike became involved in the project about a year ago and minor modifications have been done to the plan. The number of units, roadway layout, wetland disturbance, flood plain disturbance, replication and drainage pattern will remain the same as previously approved. A Conservation restriction will be placed on 7.3 acres adjacent to the wetlands. The proposed change is to the building coverage which is slightly less with units being 3-stories tall. The footprint has shrunken but the buildings are taller. The other modification is the shrinkage of the alley way and the elimination of parking spaces in front of the garages. The project will still have three parking spaces per unit and there will be no change to the wetlands.

Mr. Etoniru requested a summary sheet of the area of impervious for the Commission to review.

Mr. Flattery will provide a summary between the plans produced by Watson Engineering and the new plans.

Mr. Etoniru suggested an email with the summary prior to the next meeting on July 12, 2023.
