Raynham Planning Board Meeting Minutes Thursday, April 20, 2023

Call to Order

Mr. Fountain opened the meeting of April 20, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. and informed the meeting is being broadcast live on the Raynham Comcast Channel 98 and Verizon Channel 34 and videotaped by RayCam.

Public Hearing - 450 South Street West Abbreviated Site Plan:

Mr. Andrade read the Public Hearing Notice.

Present was Rebecca Baptiste, P.E., from Silva Engineering, Bridgewater, MA. The proposed plan is for the renovation of an existing building at 450 South Street West/corner of Richmond Street for an HVAC business. The plan shows outside storage in the existing fenced-in area. The application has been reviewed by Raynham Conservation Commission, and they deemed it as adequate. The Conservation Commission requested snow storage area to be depicted on the plan as well as a guiderail and signage for a no-snow dumping area along one side of the property.

Mr. Fountain discussed a small trench in front of the building that he noticed today. Mr. Oldfield noted, and Ms. Baptiste agreed, that it is probably for utilities.

Mr. Oldfield suggested the installation of bollards in front of each parking space along the front of the building.

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The project will have no increase in impervious surface, the parking spaces comply with zoning requirements, and ADA parking has been added to the site.

There were no further comments or questions, and Mr. Fountain asked for a motion to accept.
