To the Honorable Board of Selectmen:

The Raynham sewer system has over 75 miles of sewers and 34 pump stations. Over 90% of homes in Raynham now have sewer service available. There are currently 4,500 domestic customers and 300 commercial accounts.

During 2016, the Sewer Department continued with the expansion of sewer service to southeast Raynham. The most recent phase # VI included the following accomplishments:

- 1. Completion of Contract # 3 for new sewers where residents were invited to tie in on Route 44, Church Street (north of the Taunton River), Dean Street, Hill Street, Captains Landing, Suzanne Drive, Gretchen Way, Adam Lane and Sarah Lane. This project included two new pump stations and new asphalt surfaces.
- 2. Construction of new sewer lines on Church Street (south of the Taunton River), River Street and River Brook Drive, plus two new pump stations. Fifty-eight homes and several apartment buildings will be invited to tie into these new sewer lines in April 2017.

The Sewer Department also undertook a three year program to reduce infiltration and inflow into our older sewer lines. Phase 1 of that program was completed in the Pine Hill Estates area. Phases 2 and 3 will continue along the Route 44 strip and up to Pleasantfield.

The Board would like to thank Richard Schiavo for his 11 years of continuous service as an elected Sewer Commissioner. Richard's dedication and leadership guided the Board through the lengthy negotiations with the City of Taunton and the MA DEP permitting for sewer expansion into southeast Raynham.
