To the Honorable Board of Selectmen:

The Raynham sewer system has over 75 miles of sewers and 34 pump stations. The number of homes in Raynham with sewer service available is 92 %, with 76 % actually connected to the system. We currently have 4,145 domestic and commercial accounts.

During 2017, the Sewer Department continued with the expansion of sewer service to southeast Raynham. The most recent phase # 6 of sewer expansion included the following accomplishments:

- 1. Completion of Contract # 4/5 for new sewers on Church Street (south of the Taunton River), River Street and River Brook Drive. This project included two new pump stations and new asphalt surfaces. Fifty three homes were invited to tie into this new sewer line in April 2017.
- 2. Completion of Contract # 6 for new sewer lines on Locust Street between the water tower and Goldfinch Drive. Twenty six homes were invited to tie into this new sewer line in April 2017.

The developer for the Bassett Knoll subdivision completed construction of a new pump station for the Department this year.

The Sewer Department is presently conducting detailed study for future sewer expansion.

The Sewer Department also continued with its three year program to reduce infiltration and inflow into our older sewer lines. Sewer line repairs from Phase 1 were completed this year in the Pine Hill Estates area. Phase 2 inspection was completed on South Street West and along the Route 44 strip.
