What To Bring

Unneeded household hazardous waste in sealed, original containers.

- Oil Paints, Stains, Thinners
- Solvents & Varnishes
- Adhesives, Glues, Resins
- Waste Fuels (Kerosene, Gasoline)
- Engine Degreaser, Brake Fluid
- Transmission Fluid
- Insecticides, Weed Killers
- Wood Preservatives
- Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- Photo Chemicals, Chemistry Sets
- Cleaners, Spot Removers
- Swimming Pool Chemicals
- Car Batteries, Dry Cell Batteries
- Aerosol Cans
- Pesticides
- NiCad Batteries
- Hearing Aid (Button) Batteries
- Latex Paint



What Not To Bring

- Unknown Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives
- Prescription Medicines/Syringes
- Infectious & Biological Waste
- Radioactive Waste
- Fire extinguishers

To ensure safety, please:

- Tighten caps and lids leaving materials in original labeled containers.
- Do not mix chemicals!
- Pack your vehicle and go directly to the site. NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous materials.
- **Do not place waste in a garbage bag.**
