Ch. 30, Sec. 39M, the Town of Raynham through its Park & Recreation Dept. is seeking qualified contractors to supply and install a chain link fence at the McKenney Memorial Baseball Field. Complete bid packages may be obtained as of 8/11/23 on the Town website at www.town.raynham.ma.us, COMMBUYS, or by e-mailing gbarnes@town.raynham.ma.us. Sealed bids must be received at the Parks & Recreation Office, 2254 King Philip Street, Raynham, MA 02767 on or before 8/31/23 at 10:00 A.M., at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened.

The Town reserves the right and may cancel this Invitation for Bids or reject in whole or in part any and all bids if the Town determines that serves the best interests of the Town.

TOWN OF RAYNHAM INVITATION FOR BIDS CHAIN LINK FENCE SUPPLY & INSTALLATION

I. GENERAL INFORMATION AND BID SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30B, Section 39M, the Town of Raynham, Massachusetts, through its Park & Recreation Department, is seeking qualified contractors to supply and install a black chain link fence at the McKenney Memorial Baseball Field located at Borden Colony on King Phillip Street in Raynham, MA 02767.

Bid packages may be obtained as of Friday, August 11, 2023 on the Town website at www.town.raynham.ma.us or by e-mailing gbarnes@town.raynham.ma.us. Sealed bids marked "BID – CHAIN LINK FENCE SUPPLY & INSTALLATION" will be accepted at the Park & Recreation Office, 2254 King Philip Street, Raynham, MA 02767 on or before Thursday, August 31, 2023 at 10:00 A.M., at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened by the Park & Recreation Director or his designee. Bids received after such time will not be accepted.

The Bids shall be reviewed for responsiveness by an Evaluation Committee composed of the Park & Recreation Director and Town Administrator/Chief Procurement Officer. These individuals shall review the Bids based solely on the specifications set forth in the I.F.B. The contract shall be awarded to the responsive and responsible bidder with the lowest cost within twenty (20) days of the opening, unless the time for award is extended by mutual consent of the parties. Bidder shall execute a formal contract within ten (10) days of the Notice of Award, unless the execution date is extended by mutual consent of the parties. All bid prices are to remain valid through the execution date.

If any changes are made to this I.F.B. an addendum will be issued. Any addendum issued will be e-mailed to all bidders on record as having requested the I.F.B.

Questions concerning this I.F.B. must be submitted in writing to the Park & Recreation Department or e-mailed to gbarnes@town.raynham.ma.us. No question shall be considered which is not in writing. Any questions requiring consideration shall be answered in an Addendum e-mailed to all registered responders.

A bidder may correct, modify, or withdraw a bid by written notice received by the Town prior to the bid submission deadline. Bid modifications must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly labeled "Modification NO. ____." Each modification must be numbered in sequence, and must reference the original I.F.B.

After bid opening, a bidder may not change any provision of the bid in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the Town or fair competition. Minor informalities will be waived or the bidder will be allowed to correct them. If a mistake and the intended bid are clearly evident on the face of the bid document, the mistake will be corrected to reflect the intended correct bid, and the bidder will be notified in writing; the

bidder may not withdraw the bid. A bidder may withdraw a bid if a mistake is clearly evident on the face of the bid documents, but the intended correct bid is not similarly evident.

The Town reserves the right and may cancel this I.F.B. or reject in whole or in part any and all bids if the Town determines that cancellation or rejection serves the best interests of the Town. It may negotiate with the successful bidder to finalize details of proposed contract.

If, at the time of the scheduled bid submission deadline, the Park & Recreation Office is closed due to uncontrolled events such as fire, snow, ice, wind, building evacuation or illness, bids will be accepted until 10:00 A.M. the next normal business day.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope. The following sections need to be filled out and submitted in the sealed envelope:

- Signed Price Bid Form with Bid Price (Attachment A)
- Certification of Tax Compliance and of Non-collusion Statement (Attachment B)
- Affidavit of Labor Harmony and OSHA Compliance (Attachment C)
- Contractor References (Attachment D)

In addition, within the sealed envelope, a bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check payable to the Town of Raynham is required in a dollar amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount must be included.

Bidders must be able to comply with all of the I.F.B. specifications in order for your bid to be accepted. Please read all of the I.F.B. specifications and follow all instructions in preparing your I.F.B. response. Failure to respond properly may result in the REJECTION of your bid.

Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Labor and Industries under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27G, as amended, apply to this project (see Attachment F for schedules). It is the responsibility of the contractor, before bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Prevailing Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract.

The successful bidder shall possess the skill, ability and integrity necessary for the faithful performance of the work, shall be able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed, or to be employed, in the work, and shall otherwise comply with all applicable provisions of law. All employees to be employed in the work subject to this bid will have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health administration that is at least 10 hours in duration.

Successful bidder will provide 50% payment bond if contract is more than \$25,000.

A site inspection appointment can be scheduled by contacting the Park & Recreation Director, Timothy McRae, at 508-824-2743. The inspection will allow prospective

contractors to familiarize themselves with all conditions that may affect the performance and cost of the contract. Failure to become familiarized with all conditions shall not constitute a basis for subsequent contract change orders. The project site, the field of which has a sign, is located to right of the Raynham Council on Aging/Senior Center (COA), 2215 King Philip Street, Raynham, MA.

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Scope of Services is as follows:

- 4 feet all black chain link fence for approximately 1,046 feet, including down the right and left field lines and the outfield fence;
- Approximately 96 feet all black chain link fence for the backstop, 3 tiered and 18 feet high;
- Approximately 34 feet of all black chain link in front of the dugouts, 17 feet long and 6 feet high in front of each dugout;
- Approximately 120 feet of all black chain link along the infield by the dugouts, 8-foot-high fence from backstop to outfield where it meets the gate in left field and 4 feet fence in right field;
- 9-gauge steel core by 2-inch black chain link fence;
- Two 4'x 4' gates;
- One 4' x 12'double gate;
- Install 2 ½ inch posts, 1 5/8-inch top rail for standard fence;
- Install 4-inch posts, 9-gauge steel core by 2-inch black chain link fence, 1 5/8 inch top and mid rail for backstop;
- Top rail and bottom fence tension wire along the entire fence for approximately 1,300 feet;
- Remove all debris and clean-up site;
- And secure permits as needed to meet all Town building codes.

Please note that the Town of Raynham will be taking down and removing old fence and posts.

III. MINIMUM CRITERIA

Bidders must provide all of the services described in Section II: Scope of Services, and comply with all Bid Submission Requirements listed in Section I.

IV. REFERENCES

Bidders must submit a list of at least three contracts performed in the past three (3) years that are similar in size and scope of this contract with contact names and telephone numbers. Poor references may be a basis for a determination that the bidder is not a responsible bidder. Reference Form is included in the bid package as Attachment D.

V. RULE FOR AWARD

The Town will award the contract to the responsive and responsible bidder offering the lowest total price for all required services as indicated in the bid documents pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30B, Section 39M.

VI. BID PRICING SHEET

Bid pricing sheet is included with the bid package as Attachment A.

VII. NON-COLLUSION FORM AND TAX COMPLIANCE FORM

Bidders must submit a certification of tax compliance and non-collusion with a bid. Copies of the forms are included with the bid package as Attachment B.

VIII. AFFIDAVIT OF LABOR HARMONY AND OSHA COMPLIANCE

Bidders must submit an affidavit of labor harmony and OSHA compliance with a bid. A copy of the form is included with the bid package as Attachment C.

IX. BID DEPOST

A bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check payable to the Town of Raynham is required in a dollar amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount.

X. ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. <u>Compliance with Laws and Regulations</u>. Contractor shall comply with all laws and regulations including regulations of prevailing wages, salaries and workers compensation. Departures will be promptly corrected and shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
- B. <u>Insurance</u>. The contractor shall be responsible to the Town or any third party for any property damage or bodily injury caused by it, any of its subcontractors,

employees or agents in the performance of, or as a result of, the work under this Agreement. The contractor and any subcontractors used hereby certify that they are insured for workers' compensation, property damage, personal and product liability. The Contractor and any subcontractor it uses shall purchase, furnish copies of, and maintain in full force and effect insurance policies in the amounts here indicated.

General Liability

Per Occurrence: \$1,000,000 Per Project Aggregate: \$2,000,000

Property Damage Liability

Per Occurrence: \$1,000,000 Per Project Aggregate: \$2,000,000

Automobile Liability

Prior to commencement of any work under this Agreement, the contractor shall provide the Town with Certificates of Insurance which include the Town as an additional named insured and which include a thirty (30) day notice of cancellation to the Town.

C. <u>Hold Harmless</u>. The contractor shall indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Town, and all of its officers, agents, and employees against all suits, claims of liability of every name and nature, for or on account of any injuries to persons or damage to property arising out of the negligence of the contractor in the performance of the work covered by this contract and/or failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the contract, whether by himself or his employees or subcontractors.

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

- · The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multiyear CM AT RISK projects, the awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts. The updated wage schedule must be provided to all contractors, including general and sub-contractors, working on the construction project.
- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- · An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or a sub-
- Apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS). Apprentices must keep their apprentice identification card on their persons during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DAS regardless of whether they are registered with another federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the iournevworker's rate.
- · Every contractor or subcontractor working on the construction project must submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. For a sample payroll reporting form go to http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- · Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- · Contractors must obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities. Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
- · Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may file a complaint with the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
