

Notice of Public Informational Meeting RAYNHAM COMPLETE STREETS PRIORITIZATION PLAN

The Town of Raynham will be holding a Public **Informational** Meeting on January 12, 2022, at 6:00 PM to discuss the development of a Complete Streets Prioritization Plan for the Town. This meeting will be held in person as follows:

Veterans Memorial Town Hall Selectmen's Board Room 558 South Main Street Raynham

The meeting presentation will be posted on the Town's website with tools to allow you to submit feedback online.

What is a Complete Street? A "complete street" provides accommodations for all users, including motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, and persons with disabilities.

Do you have an idea to make walking, bicycling, or riding public transit in Raynham safer and more attractive? Possible complete street improvements may include new sidewalk construction, improved lighting, intersection modifications, improved pedestrian crossings, accessibility improvements, enhanced bicycling infrastructure, or transit stop improvements.

The focus of this meeting will be to gather public feedback on:

- An overview of the MassDOT Complete Streets Program
- A draft complete streets policy for Raynham
- An overview of existing conditions and identification of local needs
- Brainstorming possible complete streets projects

A follow-up Public **Informational** Meeting will be held in February to get public input on a list of projects and priorities. The prioritization plan will be submitted to and approved by MassDOT as part of the Town's ongoing participation in their Complete Streets Program.
