The meeting presentation will be posted on the Town's website with tools to allow you to submit feedback online.

What is a Complete Street? A "complete street" provides accommodations for all users, including motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, and persons with disabilities.

This meeting follows from the January 12th meeting and will present a list of possible complete street improvements for public feedback. Possible complete street improvements may include new sidewalk construction, improved lighting, intersection modifications, improved pedestrian crossings, accessibility improvements, enhanced bicycling infrastructure, or transit stop improvements.

The focus of this meeting will be to gather public feedback on:

- A possible list of projects. Are there others that should be added to the list?
- What projects should be prioritized for implementation.

Feedback from the public will be incorporated into the list of projects and prioritization. The draft prioritization plan will be submitted to and approved by MassDOT as part of the Town's ongoing participation in their Complete Streets Program.
